D4	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Beijing → Chengdu</b></p> <p>Morning: Visit Tiananmen Square, which is the world's largest public square of epic proportions. .          Afternoon: Take flight to Chengdu.</p>  	Chengdu

D5	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Chengdu</b></p> <p>Morning: Visit Chengdu Research Base of Giant Panda Breeding, which serves as the world's preeminent institution for giant panda ex-situ conservation, scientific research and breeding, popular science education and cultural tourism.</p> <p>Afternoon: Visit Jinli Ancient Street, where you can enjoy Sichuan Opera Performance, taste different kinds of local snacks and experience the local folk art culture. Later, visit Wuhou Temple, which is named after Zhuge Liang, who lived from 181 until 234 AD. Afterwards, drive to Dujiangyan City.</p> <p>Evening: Enjoy the beautiful scenery of night market near South Bridge in Dujiangyan City.</p> 	Dujiangyan
D6	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Dujiangyan→Aba Tibetan and Qiang Autonomous Prefecture</b></p> <p>Morning: Visit the Dujiangyan Irrigation System Construction, which began in the 3rd century B.C and now still controls the waters of the Minjiang River and distributes it to the fertile farmland of the Chengdu plains.</p> <p>Afternoon: Visit Mount Qingcheng, which is the birthplace of Taoism and consists of a series of ancient temples. Later, drive to Aba Tibetan and Qiang Autonomous Prefecture and have a rest in hotel.</p> 	Aba Tibetan and Qiang Autonomous Prefecture
D7	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Bipenggou Valley</b></p> <p>Whole day: Visit Bipenggou Valley, which is an original ecological scenic area, with altitude between 2000m and 5000m, and combines primitive natural landscape, favorable ecological environment as well as various outdoor entertaining activities. It becomes most attractive when the autumn dyes the forest yellow, golden, orange, red, etc.</p> <p>In Bipenggou Scenic Area, you will see virgin forests, plateau lakes, snow-capped mountains, all-year-round glaciers, alpine meadows, limpid streams and waterfalls. It is a piece of pure land with zero air pollution index. Afternoon: Free activities and shopping.




